PLEASE READ THESE RULES CAREFULLY BEFORE FILLING IN THE ENTRY FORM

Conditions of Entry

1. This event is open to BJC, BJA & AJA. Entrant's must produce a current, valid Judo licence properly completed with their details including photograph and date of birth upon booking in at the event.
2. Tournament entry is £15 per person for Seniors plus £7.50 per person for each additional Kata and £10 per person for Juniors plus £5 per person for each additional Kata.
3. All entries must be received by the end of the 13th November 2019.
4. We reserve the right to restrict any category.
5. Individual entrants (if 18 or over), their parents (if under 18) and their coaches should satisfy themselves that the entrant is in a physical condition to participate in this event. Any doubts should be referred to Head Office at least one week before the tournament (or the Tournament Director, on the day, if something has arisen immediately prior to the event).
6. There may be ongoing medical issues which, whilst not precluding entry are nonetheless, issues of which the judges on the mat should be aware. It is a requirement that such issues are detailed on the entry form. An example would be "Asthmatic needs an inhaler at the side of the mat".
7. The BJC reserve the right to record by film or video, all or any part of the Tournament.
8. Entrants should enter the category for the oldest member of the pair.
9. Kata pairs may be made of single or mixed gender but can only enter a category once.
10. Registration opens at 1pm for a prompt start at 2pm (We hope to be able to have a practice mat open as early as possible).

Tournament Regulations

-  No coaching will be allowed during the Tournament
-  Judogi must comply with BJC contest rules. Females must additionally wear a plain white high neck T-shirt. Please see http://bjcjudoevents.org.uk/bjc_contest_rules.pdf
-  For reason of safety drink containers or refreshments are not allowed matside.
-  All competitors must comply with the regulations regarding footwear, i.e. Zori only to be worn to the side of the mat. Trainers, crocs or other shoes etc are not permitted.
-  Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be available in all categories.
-  For safety, only wooden weapons are permitted & guns must have no trigger guard.
-  Photographs and video will be taken at this event. If you do not wish your child to be photographed, please speak to the Tournament organisers prior to your child demonstrating who will use their best endeavors to prevent your child being videoed or photographed.
